DAY 6: Chioggia, Venice

This morning, you'll have a choice of excursions. You may set sail on the waters of Italy's largest nature reserve, the UNESCO-protected Po Delta. Enjoy refreshments onboard as your boat meanders leisurely for two hours through serene wetlands, where the meeting of the Po River and the Adriatic Sea creates a peaceful haven for wildlife. Nature-lovers and birdwatchers will especially appreciate the chance to spot a multitude of rare and beautiful species. Storks, purple heron and a remarkable colony of more than 10,000 pink flamingos are among the easier residents to admire as you glide through this extraordinary landscape.

Alternatively, you may opt for a guided tour of Castello del Catajo, an impressive historic estate filled with grand halls, elaborate frescoes and centuries of Venetian history.

DAY 7: Venice

As your water taxi glides through Venice's narrow canals and along the Canal Grande, you'll arrive in style at the Rialto Bridge. 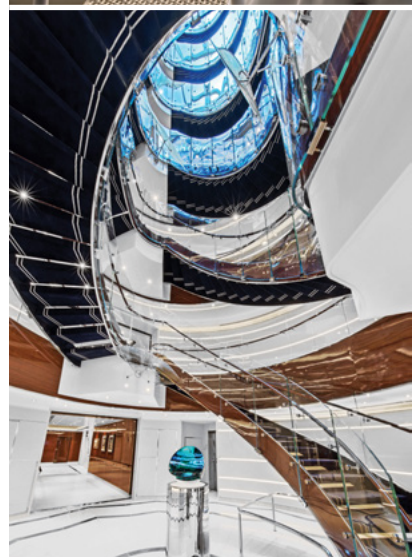

DAY 1: Piraeus (Athens)

DAY 2: Nafplion, Greece

Often described as one of the loveliest small towns in Greece, Nafplion captivates with its seaside charm, Venetian fortress and dramatic setting beneath rocky headlands. Today you may book a variety of enriching excursions, such as a locally inspired Greek cooking class, a guided visit to Palamidi Castle and the Archaeological Museum, or a private tasting and lunch at Domaine Skouras Winery. Each excursion is available at an additional cost.

DAY 3: Day at Sea

Relax and enjoy a full day aboard your ultra-luxury ship. Lounge on deck, take in uninterrupted sea views, indulge in world-class cuisine or sip a cocktail by the pool as the Mediterranean sun drifts overhead - a serene day designed for pure enjoyment.

DAY 4: Kotor, Montenegro

Set against towering limestone cliffs and surrounded by one of the Mediterranean's most breathtaking landscapes, Kotor is a treasure of medieval architecture. Once under Venetian rule, its winding streets are filled with cathedrals, palaces and centuries-old charm.
